- 35 worked directly with the Youth Employment Specialist for the Colorado Workforce Center and the trades and apprentice coordinator.
- 49 worked on Financial Aid / Scholarship applications
- 458 College apps were submitted 349 of those applications were to Colorado Colleges and Universities. Since the Colorado colleges waived their application fee for this event (\$55 average cost). Our students saved right around 19 thousand dollars in application fees.

CASH FOR COLLEGE


The Mensa Education and Research Foundation is offering scholarships for students of all ages. The application period is open from Sept. 15 through Jan. 15.
