Letter from Principal Todd McClaskey

Greetings Wildcat community,

Fruita Monument students and staff are involved in a wide variety of activities as we head into fall. School spirit is high as our students pour out to support our teams and show Fruita Pride. Our goal is that every student will find a group where he or she can participate in positive experiences and give back to their school and community. It is important to note that there is a high correlation with high achieving students and involvement in extracurricular activities such as Fine Arts – Band, Art, Orchestra or Choir, Athletics, FFA, service clubs, and many other organizations. The second week of October brings the much anticipated homecoming week and all the festivities that come with it. This year's theme is "Island in the Sun". Student Council has scheduled many fun activities all week (see the following pages for a full schedule).

I am excited to welcome the community to our first drama productions for the school year. The FMHS Drama Club will be performing "A Doll's House." A Doll's House is a three-act play written by Norway's Henrik Ibsen. It premiered at the Royal Theatre in Copenhagen, Denmark, on 21 December 1879. The play will run October 18 and 19 at 7pm and Saturday, October 21 at 2pm and 7pm. Tickets are \$8 for adults, \$6 for students.

Additionally, PNCL, Chamberlain Architects, and The Blythe Group began construction on a parking lot just east of the gymnasium. This new parking lot will add 182 spaces and provide better access to the fields and gymnasiums for our students, staff, and community. The project is expected to be completed in November. 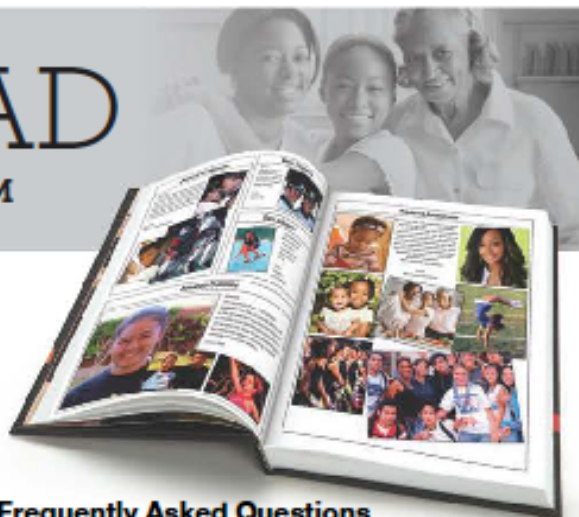

Two twenty-five minute **critical reading** sections

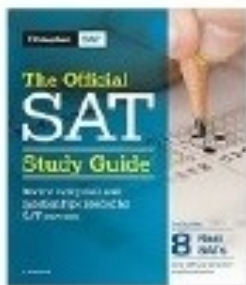


